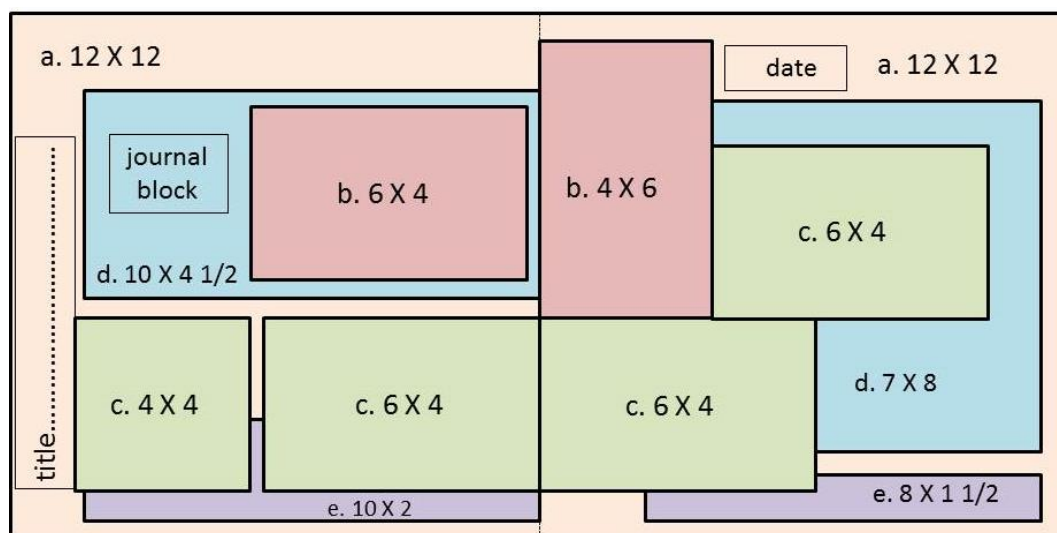


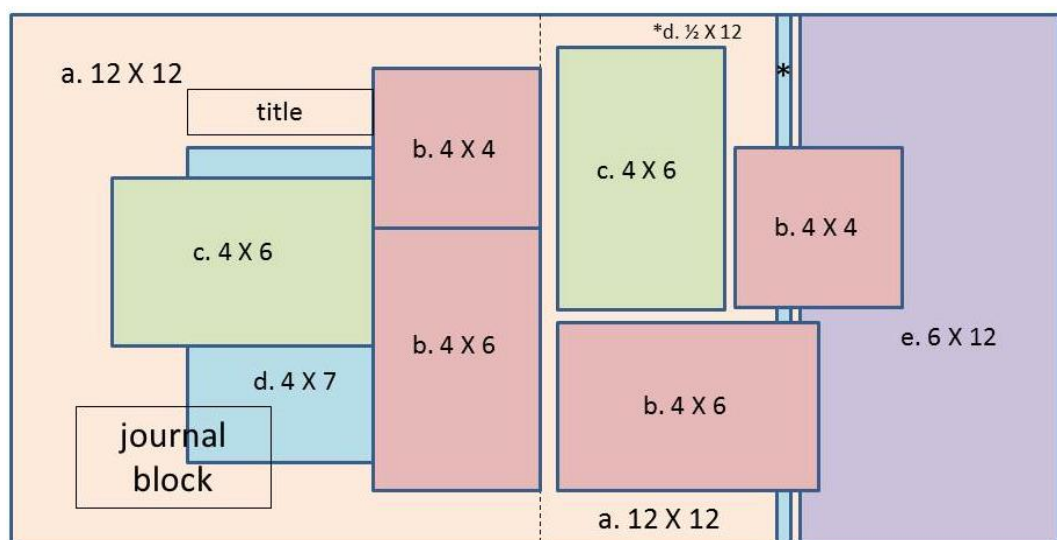

Supplies: one set of supplies will be enough for BOTH 2 page layouts

- a.** 4 sheets of cardstock : same or mix & match – set aside for backgrounds
- b.** 1 sheet of cardstock for mats
 - cut 4– 4 X 6 and 2-4 X 4
 - to do so:** cut 3– 4 X 12 pieces, then cut 2 in half to get 4 – 4 X 6. cut remaining 4 X 12 in thirds to get 2-4 X 4
- c.** 1 sheet of cardstock for mats
 - cut 5– 4 X 6 and 1 – 4 X 4
 - to do so:** cut 3– 4 X 12 pieces, then cut 2 in half to get 4 – 4 X 6, and cut 1 – 4 X 6 and 1 – 4 X 4 from last strip
- d.** 1 sheet of printed paper
 - cut 1 – 4 X 7, 1 – 7 X 8, 1 – 10 1/2 X 4 1/2 and 1-1/2X12
 - to do so:** cut a 7 X 12 piece and cut at 8” to get 4 X 7 and 7 X 8, then trim 1/2 X 12 off one long side of the 4 1/2 X 12, then trim piece to 4 1/2 X 10
- e.** 1 sheet of printed paper
 - cut 1 – 6 X 12, 1 – 10 X 2 and 1 – 8 X 1 1/2
 - to do so:** cut a 6 X 12, then cut a 2 X 12 strip and trim to 2 X 10, then cut a 1 1/2 X 12 and trim to 1 1/2 X 8.

Instructions:

***ink papers as desired before adhering**

- 1) cut papers according to list above ; you may want to jot size down in pencil on the back to make assembly easier.
- 2) adhere all papers as shown.
- 3) use photos of layouts as a guide for placement of title and photos.
